1. Print the page(s) with the pieces you'll need. For a small Love Frog, print page 2. For a large Love Frog, print pages 3-6.
2. Color the hearts and other pieces using your favorite colors. Princess Cassandra loves green, so she wanted a great green frog for her perfect pet... but there are so many different kinds of frogs in the world--in almost every color imaginable. And scientists keep discovering new frogs, so they might find one in your favorite color tomorrow! Your frog doesn't have to be green. It could be red or blue or yellow or brown, or even rainbow!
3. Cut out the pieces for your Love Frog and glue them together, like the illustration in the bottom corner of the page. (You may want to glue the frog to the front of a card after you assemble it.)
4. Give your frog to your favorite Valentine!

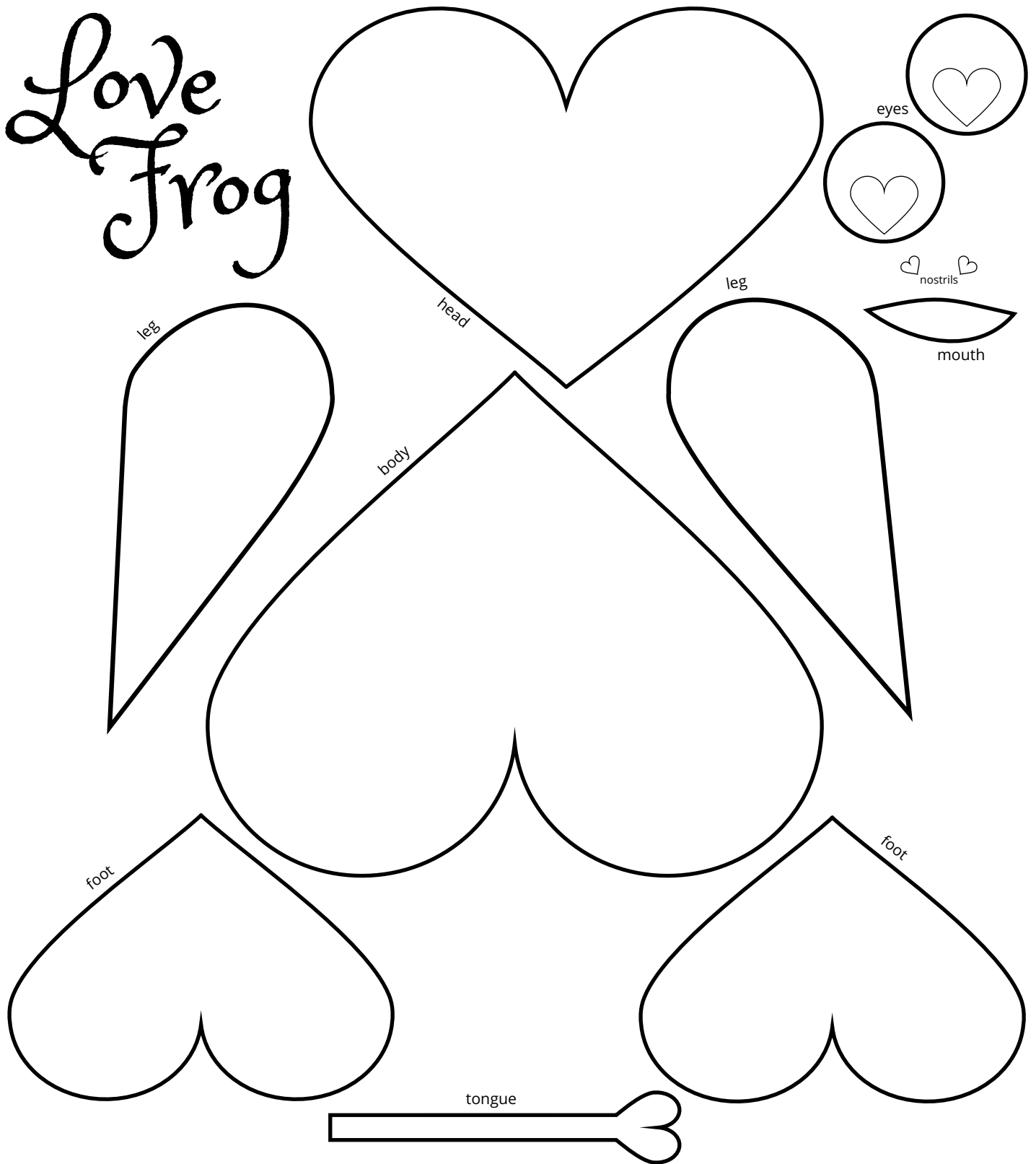
